Your application will not be considered valid until all the necessary information and original document(s) have been produced and the relevant fee has been paid. If there are restrictions on the length of time you may work in the UK, your licence will not be issued for any longer than this period. In such circumstances the check will be repeated each time you apply to renew or extend your licence. If, during this period,

you are disqualified from holding a licence because you have not complied with the UK's immigration laws, your licence will cease to have effect and you must return it to the licensing authority. Failure to do so is a criminal offence.

I/we declare that to the best of my knowledge and belief, the answers given in this application for a private hire vehicle operator's licence are true and that the documents submitted in support of it are genuine and have not been altered.

I/we understand that if I/we have provided any information in this application or the supporting documents that I/we know to be false or do not believe to be true that I/we shall be liable for prosecution and/or any licences issued to me/us may be suspended or revoked.

I/we consent to the information provided in this application and the supporting documents being used by Sunderland City Council for the purposes of undertaking its statutory licensing functions in relation to operators of private hire vehicles and understand that it may disclose any information to any third party, as may be required by law.

I/we understand the Council is under a duty to protect the public funds it administers, and to this end I/we authorise the Council to use the information I/we have provided on this form for the prevention and detection of fraud. I/we also authorise the sharing this information with other bodies responsible for auditing or administering public funds for these purposes.
