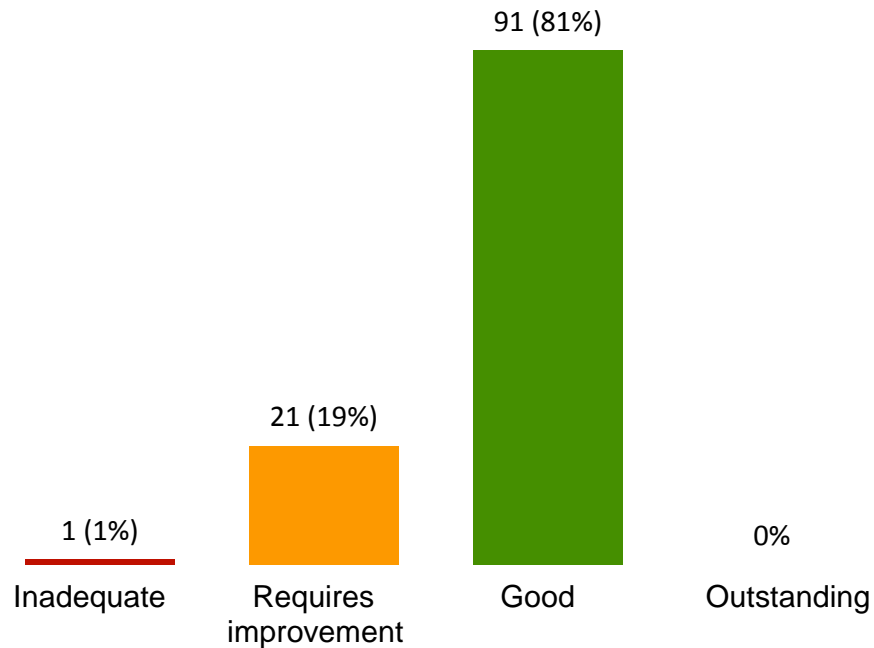

Adult social care overall ratings in local authority boundary of Sunderland

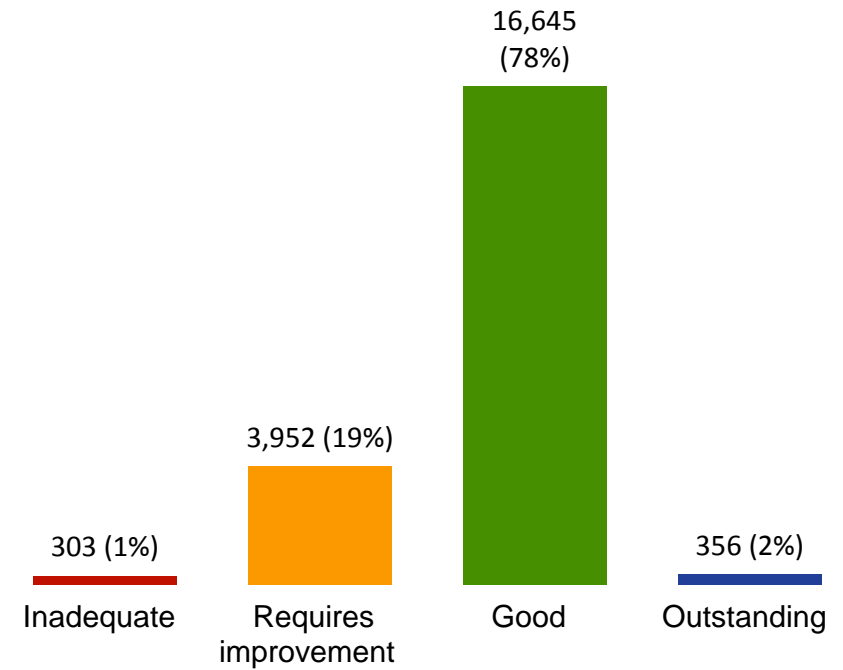

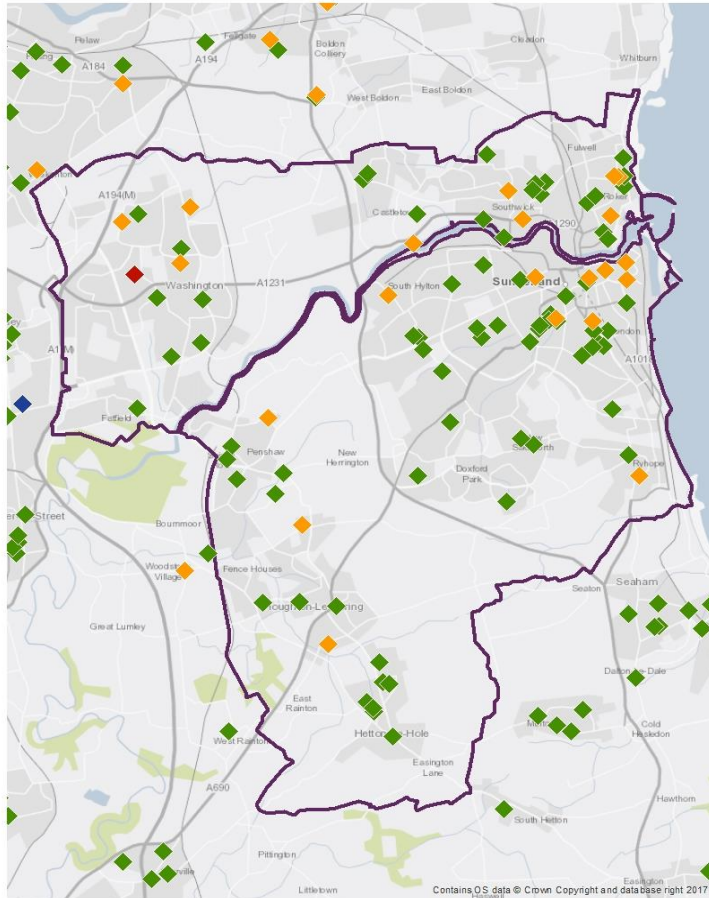

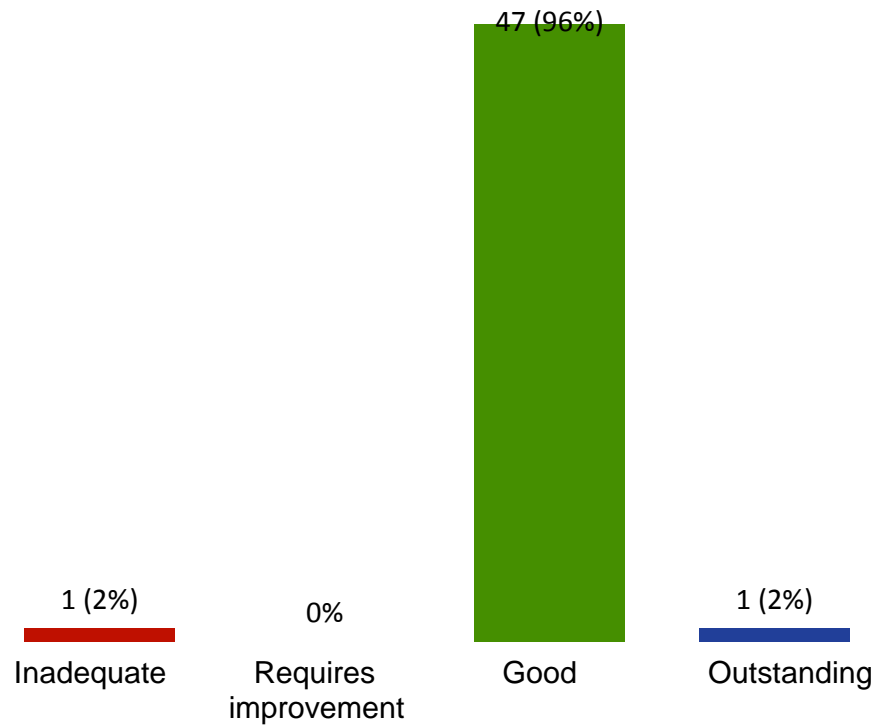

GP practice overall ratings in local authority boundary of Sunderland

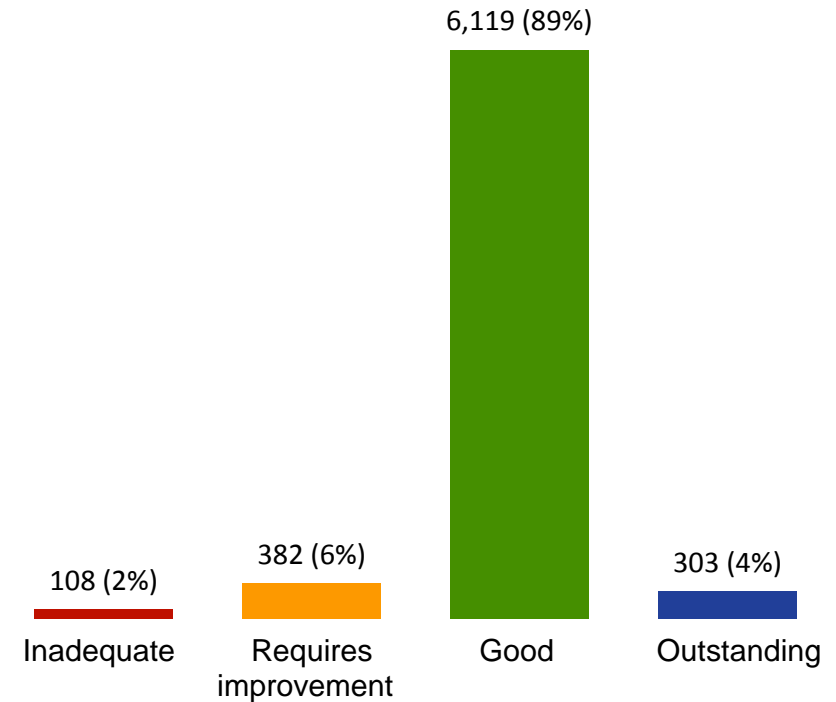

Adult social care

This includes accommodation and personal care provided in residential care homes, nursing homes and specialist colleges. Personal care provided in the community; in people's homes through domiciliary care services, extra care housing, Shared Lives schemes and supported living services.

Rating

Ratings are based on a combination of inspection findings, what patients tell us, monitoring data, and information from services. Inspectors use all the available evidence and their professional judgement, reviewed to ensure consistency.

Overall rating

We ask five key questions of service providers: are they safe, effective, caring, responsive to people's needs and well-led?
We rate each of the five key questions and aggregate them to give an overall rating.

Local authority

Here local authorities are based on the 152 counties and unitary authorities in England.
