

**DECLARATION**

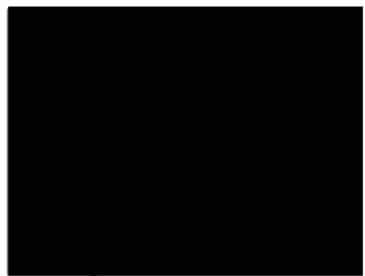
**UNDER SECTION 31 (6) HIGHWAYS ACT, 1980**

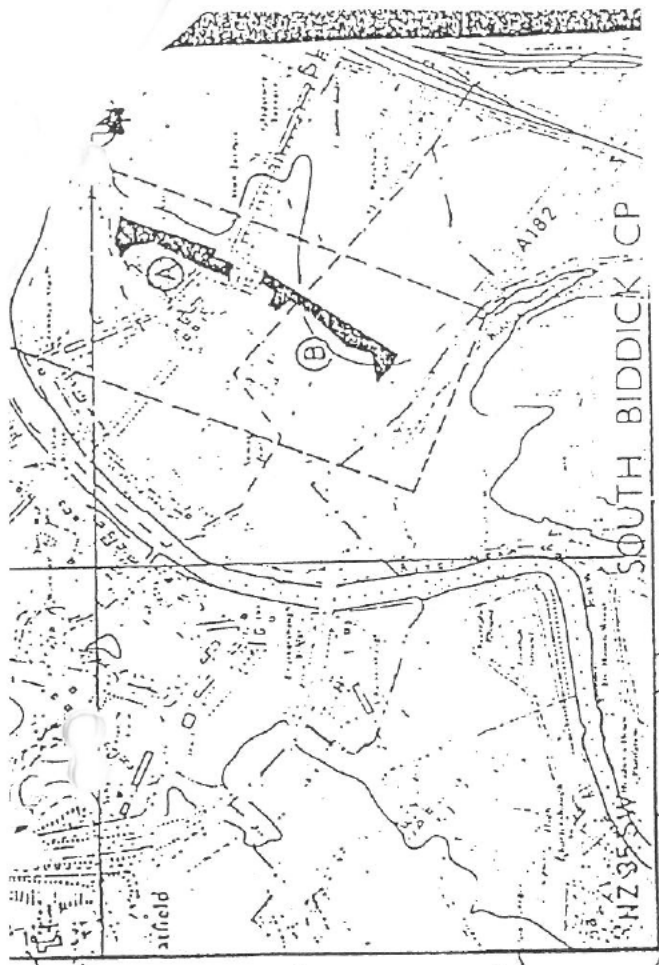
I, Graham David Bradley

1. 2. Since such deposit and statement, no ways have been dedicated by The Woodland Trust for the use of the public as highways.

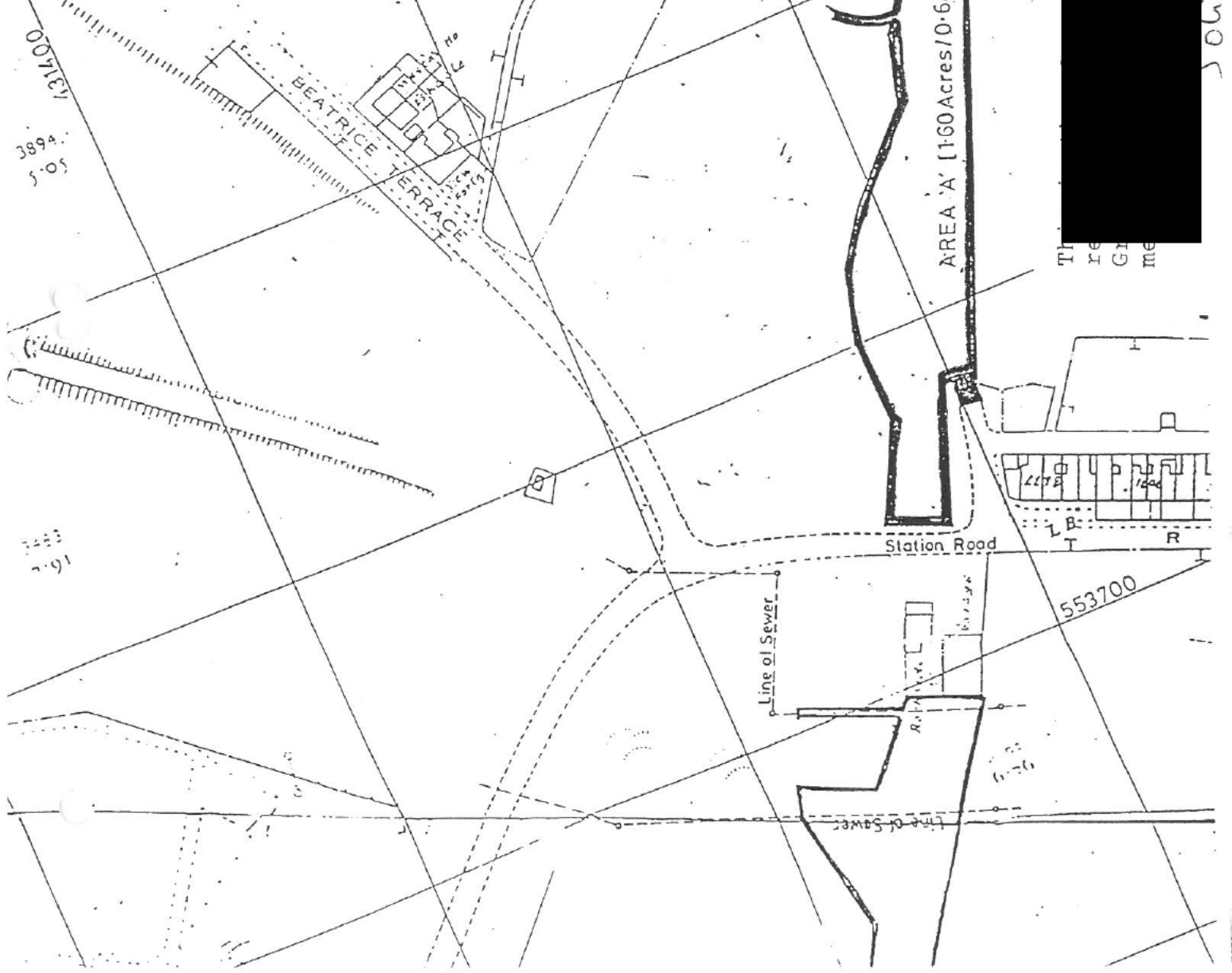

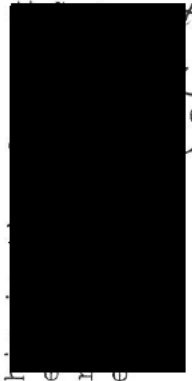




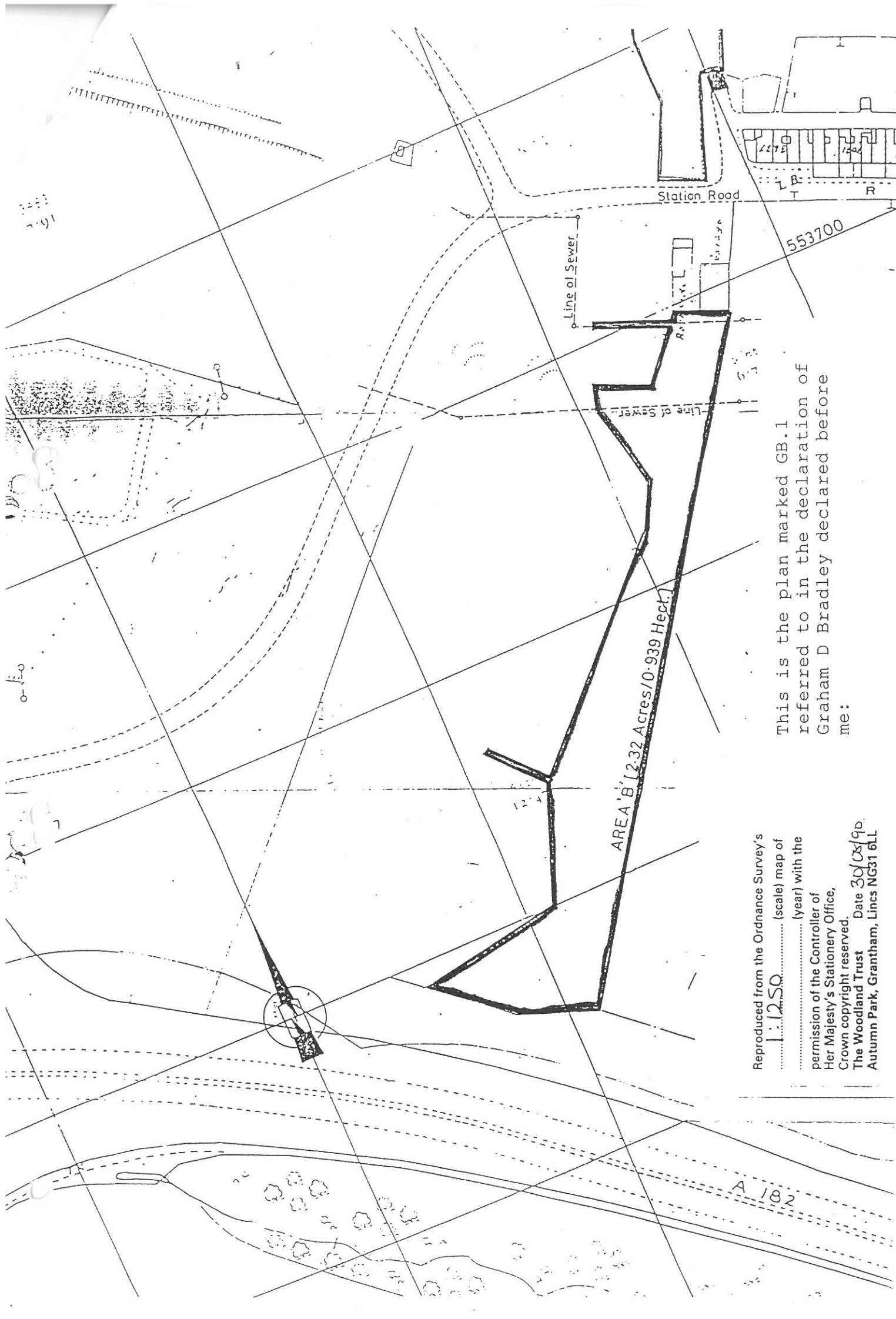
