A Potential area for teaching/scout/guides block. Situated within natural 'bowl'.
 B Existing public right of way to be bound by post and rail fence and native hedgerow.
 C Potential toilet/service block for camping
 D Potential campsite.
 E Potential area for housing livestock.
 F Existing track to be resurfaced. Track has the potential to connect to wider cycle-path network.
 G Glass houses/poly tunnels.
 H Garden centre plant area.
 I New service track to glass houses and livestock area.

J Service yard extended to accommodate larger vehicles and wind turbine.
 K Hedge planting to screen service yard.
 L Existing woodland to be maintained to improve bio-diversity.
 M External dining area extended onto raised lawn.
 N Native planting to screen service yard.
 O New natural play playground.
 P Interpretation/viewing area.
 Q New pond/wetland to provide sustainable drainage to car park.
 R New paved area with cycle parking.
 S Resurfaced and rearranged car park with tree planting.
 T Maintenance access.
 U New pedestrian/cyclist access.
 V Existing native hedge to be gapped up and extended.
 W Improved access to Stephenson Trail and access to miniature railway.
 X Miniature railway line follows line of historic railway.
