Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 19 of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, that it is the intention of Sunderland City Council, City Hall, Plater Way, Sunderland, SR1 3AA to:

- **Discontinue the existing satellite site for The Link School in Washington which is at Oxclose Community Academy, Dilston Close, Oxclose Village, Washington, NE30 0LN**

Notice is also hereby given in accordance with Paragraph 20(3), Schedule 3 of The School Organisation (Prescribed Changes to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 that it is the intention of Sunderland City Council, City Hall, Plater Way, Sunderland, SR1 3AA to :

- **Revoke decisions to establish satellite sites of The Link School in South Sunderland and Hetton which were made following publication of the proposals on 28 September 2022; and**
- **Revoke a decision to establish a resourced Social, Emotional and Mental Health Unit at The Link School which was made following publication of the proposal on 28 September 2022.**

The Link School is a Local Authority Maintained Alternative Provision Provider with sites at Springwell Dene (Swindon Road, Sunderland, SR3 4EE) and Pallion (Waverley Terrace, Pallion, SR4 6TA).
